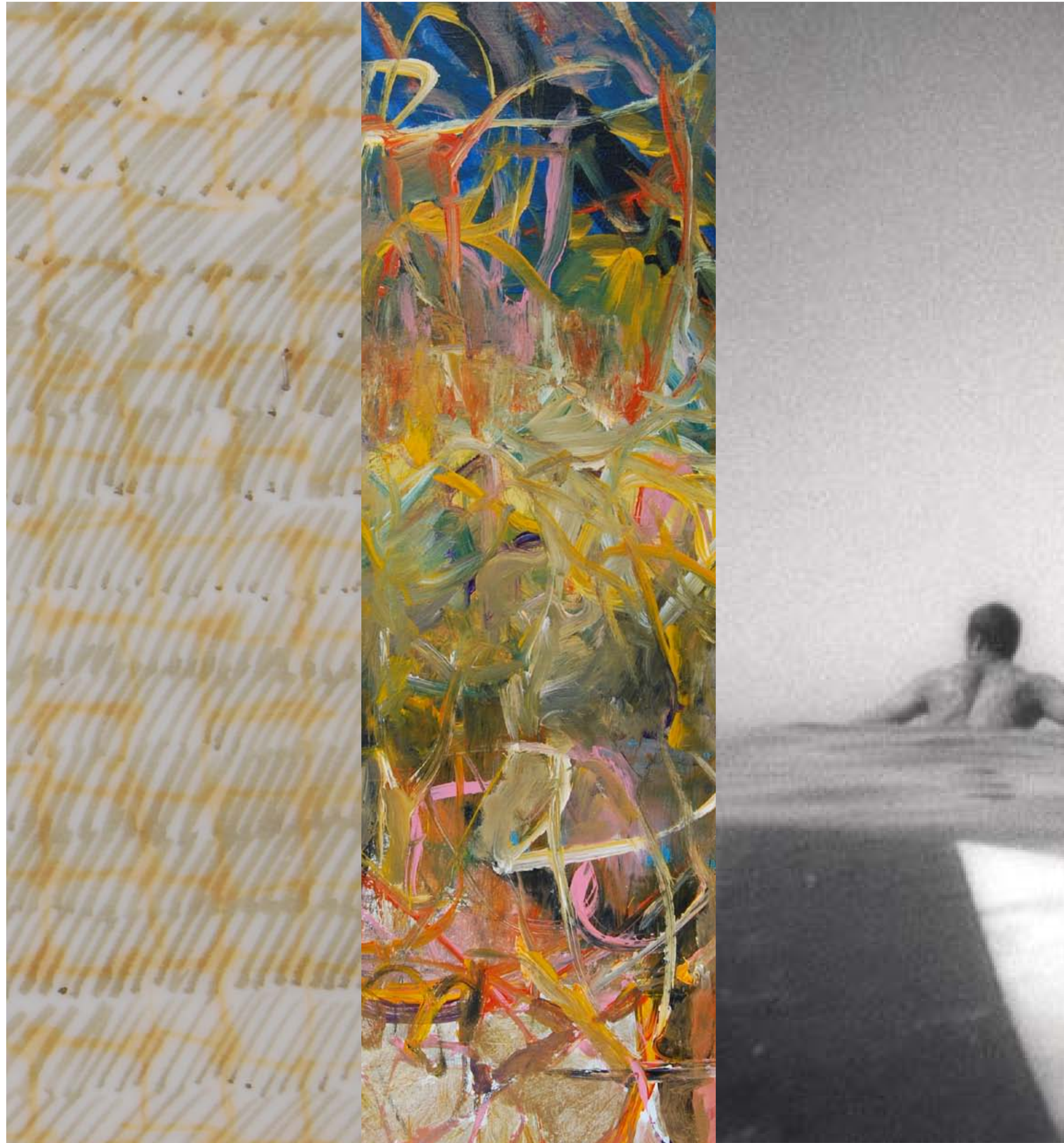


# Scratching the Surface
